

Documents Requirement for Foreign Individual

To obtain an e-KYC account as a foreign individual, certain documents are required to establish your identity, address, and other key details. Here's a comprehensive list of the essential documents:

1. Identity Proof

You will need to provide a valid documents copy of one of the following:

- Passport (Mandatory): A copy of your passport..
- Government Issued Photo ID: If available, a national ID card with a photograph may be acceptable but the passport is generally mandatory for foreign nationals.

2. Address Proof

You must provide a valid address proof document, attested as above. Choose from:

- Passport (if it contains the address)
- Driver's License
- Bank Statement (recent, typically from the last 3 months)
- Utility Bill (Electricity, Water, Gas, etc., not older than 3 months)
- Rental/Lease Agreement

3. Passport Size Photograph

- Two passport-size recent color photographs may be required.

4. Video Verification

- As part of the authentication process, applicants may conduct video verification to confirm the identity of the foreign applicant.

Note: If you mention your PAN number during the e-KYC process, you are required to share a copy of your PAN card. Additionally, during the video verification, you must show the original PAN card.
